COVID 19 Home School Agreement-

Dear Parents and Guardians,

This home school agreement is in addition to the agreement that you signed at the start of the school year but serves to keep you and your child updated during the COVID crisis. The school will operate differently due to the guidelines set by the Government which are put in place in order to keep your child and the wider community safe. Please read and discuss with your child, so you and they know what to expect at this time.

KWS Will: -

- Provide an environment that has been properly risk assessed in response to the COVID infection;
- Adhere to the safe distancing measures as set out by the government as much as practically possible;
- Provide a curriculum that meets the needs of the pupils' well-being, mental health and academic needs;
- Ask you to continue to provide open and honest answers to our COVID-related questions that we ask you fortnightly;
- Contact you if your child becomes unwell or displays any of the symptoms of COVID;
- Inform you if staff or pupils in your child's "bubble" show symptoms or test positive, as this will mean that you and your household will have to self-isolate for 14 days;
- Continue with our clear and consistent approach to rewards and sanctions as outlined in the behaviour policy. As well as in this agreement;
- Communicate home through calls, letters, emails at regular intervals whether your child is in school or not;
- Put pupils and the wider community at the heart of all of our decision making.

Parents/Guardians should: -

- Isolate for 14 days if you or anyone from your household shows symptoms of COVID 19, get tested and inform the school as soon as practically possible;
- Collect your child as soon as asked, and if needed to by the school;

- Adhere to all 2 metre distancing rules while out of your home, as much as practically possible;
- Stick to school timings as prescribed in your welcome back letter;
- Not allow my child to bring into school items from home unless prescribed by school staff, or take items home;
- Will discuss with my child safe social distancing and the need for good hand and respiratory hygiene;
- Continue to provide open and honest answers to our COVID-related questions that we ask you fortnightly;
- Read letters and emails that are sent home, and respond if required;
- Support the staff to create a safe environment;
- Ensure that uniform is clean each day of school;
- Keep all contact details up to date with the school.

Pupils should: -

- Keep to safe and social distancing rules whilst in and out of school;
- Tell staff if they feel unwell;
- Only use their allocated equipment provided by school;
- Not bring items in from home;
- Stay in my group, in the area designated for my group, not leaving site without permission;
- Follow hand washing advice, wash hands on entering and leaving the school as well as when asked to do so by staff;
- Follow respiratory health advice and sneeze into a tissue or elbow- catch it, bin it, kill it;
- Behave well at all times in order to maintain safety for yourself and others.
